- **X SKIF America Continental Karate Championship:**

The event is aimed at Shotokan Karate-Do practitioners, SKIF members, brown and black belts ages 12 and up. The total list of categories is included in a bulletin called “**Categories of the X Continental SKIF America Karate Championship**”.

- **XXXIX SKIF Mexico National and International Championship:**

The event is aimed at Shotokan Karate-Do practitioners, SKIF members, of all ages, white to purple belts; as well as brown and black belts up to 11 years old. The total list of categories is included in a bulletin called “**Categories XXXIX SKIF Mexico National and International Championship**”.

I. Registration

Registration will be done online through the official event website:

- On April 1, 2024, registration will open in general for all participants.
- On June 13, 2024, registrations will close at a normal cost.
- June 28, 2024, will be the definitive closure.

J. Prices for Competitions and Technical Seminars

Prices for competitions and technical seminars apply depending on the event in which you will participate.

- **X SKIF America Continental Karate Championship**

Costs from April 1 to June 13, 2024

- The value of individual Competitions is \$130 USD (individual kata, individual kumite or both categories).
- Technical Seminars have a value of \$120 USD (one or more seminars, per participant).
- The individual Competitions and Technical Seminars Package has a value of \$210 USD.
- The Team Competition has a value of \$150 USD (kata or kumite, per team).
- Yakusoku Kumite Competition has a value of \$100 USD.

Costs from June 14 to June 28, 2024

- Individual Competition: 150 USD.
- Technical Seminars: 150 USD.
- Individual Competitions and Technical Seminars Package: 300 USD.
- Team competition: 180 USD.
- Yakusoku Kumite: 130 USD.

- **XXXIX SKIF Mexico National and International Championship**

Costs from April 1 to June 13, 2024

- The value of the single ticket is \$1,500.00 mexican pesos (individual kata, individual kumite or both categories).
- Technical Seminars have a value of \$120 USD (one or more seminars, per participant).
- The kata or team kumite competition will have a value of \$900.00 mexican pesos, per team.

Costs from June 14 to June 28, 2024

- The National e International Championship will have a single ticket of \$2,000.00 mexican pesos.
- Technical Seminars will have a value of \$150 USD.

– Kata or team kumite will have a value of \$1,200.00 mexican pesos.

K. Awards

– In the individual categories, a first place, a second place and two third places will be awarded with medals.

– In the team categories, first place, second place and third place will be awarded with medals.

L. Hotel Information

The Holiday Inn Querétaro Zona Diamante Hotel, from the prestigious IHG Hotels & Resorts chain, is the main hotel suggested for the X SKIF America Continental Karate Championship and the XXXIX SKIF Mexico National and International Championship.
